

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Expand the Maine State Retirement System for Reemployed Individuals.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **5 MRSA §17656, sub-§1, ¶D is enacted to read:**

5 D. If the new employer is the State, the new employer must
7 include the creditable service and earnable compensation of
9 the member with the previous employer with the creditable
11 service and earnable compensation with the new employer, if
13 the previous employer was the Maine Turnpike Authority. The
15 new employer shall make, from time to time, whatever
 contributions are necessary to provide the benefits under
 the retirement system for the member as have accrued to the
 member by reason of the member's previous employment and as
 may accrue to the member by reason of the member's new
 employment.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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21 This bill requires the State to recognize creditable service
 earned by an employee of the Maine Turnpike Authority who is
 reemployed by the State in another position.
