**RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of** Maine Regarding the Undedication of Highway Funds.



Constitutional amendment. RESOLVED: 1 Two thirds of each Legislature concurring, branch of the that the following amendment to the Constitution of Maine be proposed:

## Constitution, Art. IX, §19 is repealed.

7 Constitutional referendum procedure; form of question; effective date. Resolved: That the city aldermen, town selectmen and 9 plantation assessors of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the 11 manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, at a statewide election, on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November following the passage of this resolution, to vote upon 13 the ratification of the amendment proposed in this resolution by 15 voting upon the following guestion:

17 19 "Shall the Constitution of Maine be amended by a resolution of the Legislature to undedicate the Highway Fund?"

The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall 21 vote by ballot on this question, and shall designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within the corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots shall be received, 23 sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation 25 meetings and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor 27 shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal voters are in favor of the amendment, the Governor 29 shall proclaim that fact without delay and the amendment shall become part of the Constitution on the date of the proclamation.

Secretary of State shall prepare ballots. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this resolution necessary to carry out the purposes of this referendum. 35
