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13	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "//" to H.P. 1040, L.D. 1451, Bill, "An Act Concerning Compensation for Sunday Employment"
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17	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:
19	'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664-A is enacted to read:
21	<u>\$664-A.</u> Compensation for Sunday employment
23	1. Premium pay required. Any employer who operates a
25	manufacturing facility with over 250 employees that normally operates for 24 hours a day and who requires or permits an
27	employee of that facility to work on a Sunday shall pay that employee at least 2 times the regular weekday hourly rate for
29	every hour worked by that employee on a Sunday.
31	2. Overtime rate not applicable. Neither this section nor section 664 requires such an employer to pay an employee any
33	additional amount over 2 times the regular weekday hourly rate for any overtime work performed by that employee on a Sunday.
35	Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated

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- COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1040, L.D. 1451

Provides funds for the printing and distribution costs of a wage and labor laws poster.

FISCAL NOTE

9 The bill appropriates \$13,600 from the General Fund in fiscal year 1989-90 for the one-time cost of printing and
11 distributing a new wage and labor law poster to account for the proposed changes. If other legislation is enacted which also
13 affects the wage and labor law, then the cost attributable to this bill can be reduced.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires premium pay for work performed on a Sunday by any employee of a manufacturing facility with over 250 employees that normally operates for 24 hours a day. The amendment does not require an employer to pay an employee who works overtime on a Sunday more than the double time required under the amendment.
