COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1040, L.D. 1451, Bill, "An Act Concerning Compensation for Sunday Employment"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §664-A is enacted to read:

§664-A. Compensation for Sunday employment

1. Premium pay required. Any employer who operates a manufacturing facility with over 250 employees that normally operates for 24 hours a day and who requires or permits an employee of that facility to work on a Sunday shall pay that employee at least 2 times the regular weekday hourly rate for every hour worked by that employee on a Sunday.

2. Overtime rate not applicable. Neither this section nor section 664 requires such an employer to pay an employee any additional amount over 2 times the regular weekday hourly rate for any overtime work performed by that employee on a Sunday.

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

9 The bill appropriates \$13,600 from the General Fund in  
11 fiscal year 1989-90 for the one-time cost of printing and  
distributing a new wage and labor law poster to account for the  
13 proposed changes. If other legislation is enacted which also  
affects the wage and labor law, then the cost attributable to  
15 this bill can be reduced.'

17 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

19 This amendment requires premium pay for work performed on a  
21 Sunday by any employee of a manufacturing facility with over 250  
employees that normally operates for 24 hours a day. The  
23 amendment does not require an employer to pay an employee who  
works overtime on a Sunday more than the double time required  
25 under the amendment.
