COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1042, L.D. 1453, "Resolve, to Provide Respite Care Services for Families of the Mentally Ill"

Amend the resolve in the 2nd paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 full-time"

Further amend the resolve in the 3rd paragraph after the title in the 4th line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "matters" the following: 'and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of the appropriation (page 1, lines 22 to 37 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
