21	as emergencies; and
23	Whereas, critical shortages of skilled workers in the State's health care industry have resulted in closing of beds in
25	hospitals and other health care facilities; and
27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
29	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
31	safety; now, therefore,'
33	Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "\$2157." in subsection 2, in paragraph A, in the last line (page
35	3, line 34 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "facilities." the following: 'The Department of Human Services
37	shall exempt these reimbursements for student loans from any cost
39	limits established under Medicare pursuant to 42 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 447.252 (c) or any other reimbursement
41	limits imposed by the department on nursing homes, rural health clinics and home health agencies.

17	STATEMENT OF FACT
19	This amendment requires the Department of Human Services to exempt reimbursements to nursing homes, rural health clinics and
21	home health agencies for repayment of government student loans for graduate nurses from any cost limits established by the
23	department or their agencies. This amendment also adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note.
