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1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA 163-A, sub-\$12, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 501, Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

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Statement of costs. To prepare statements pertaining 12. 7 to the existence of cost or the amount of cost to municipalities or counties for implementing or complying with a proposed law. 9 The statement of cost shall be made within the limits of information provided to the office designated by the Legislative 11 Council as having responsibility for financial analysis. The statements shall be furnished to the appropriate committee for the information of its members and for inclusion in bills which 13 receive an ought to pass report when reported by the committee. A statement shall not be necessary for any bill which has no cost 15 $(N, M) \to O$ to municipalities or counties; and

19 Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §163-A, sub-§§12-A and 12-B are enacted to read:

12-A. Revenue projections. To develop state revenue projections on a quarterly basis and for the period of the next biennium of the Legislature. The revenue projections shall be and by the office designated by the Legislative Council as having responsibility for financial analysis. The revenue projections shall be provided to the joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropriations and financial affairs; audit and program review; and taxation. Revenue projections shall be provided to other joint standing or select committees of the Legislature upon request; and

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- 31 <u>12-B. Conduct budget analyses.</u> To conduct budget analyses, including analyses of expenditures of executive branch agencies 33 and independent state agencies and legislative offices. Budget analyses shall: 35
 - A. Be conducted by the office designated by the Legislative 37 Council as having responsibility for financial analysis;
- B. Include the expenditure and use of General Fund appropriations, dedicated fund allocations, federal money,
 bond proceeds and income from any other sources for use by the agencies specified in this section; and

25 This bill provides the Legislature with the persons and resources necessary to conduct budget analyses, to develop 27 revenue projections and to conduct financial analyses. In addition, this bill requires the State Auditor to report to the 29 joint standing committees of the Legislature having jurisdiction to device appropriations and financial affairs, audit and program review, and taxation any money that a state entity has failed to 31 expend or use as appropriated by the Legislature, as well as any 33 transfers of money among accounts.

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
