

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Concerning the Imposing and Collection of Fines for Motor Vehicle
Infractions Pertaining to Rental Vehicles.



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **30-A MRSA §3010** is enacted to read:

5 **§3010. Rental vehicles; operator's responsibility**

7 No municipality may fine any person engaged in the business
9 of renting or leasing motor vehicles for a violation of any
11 traffic infraction as defined in Title 29, section 1, subsection
13 17-C, or any municipal ordinance if the vehicle is rented or
15 leased to another person at the time the violation occurred.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill will prohibit municipalities from fining motor
vehicle rental agencies for any traffic violation committed by a
lessee of one of its motor vehicles.

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
