STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Regarding the Transportation of Students.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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29 MRSA §2011, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1985, c. 191, §1, is further amended to read:

School bus. The term "school bus" shall include every 2. motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 14 or more 7 passengers, whether publicly or privately owned, which is used to transport school children to and from school or to and from 9 school activities for which such transportation is approved by 11 the appropriate school authorities, and to and from municipally operated activities or activities of a nonprofit corporation or association for which such transportation is approved by the 13 appropriate school authorities. This definition shall not include 15 private motor vehicles used to transport members of the owner's household, nor shall it include vehicles described in subsection 17 з.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would increase the number of passengers from 10 to 23 14 before a vehicle would be designated a school bus for transporting students to and from school and school activities.

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
