COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1057, L.D. 1479, Bill, "An Act to Promote Landowner Relations"

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the landowner relations program may be implemented during the fall of 1989 and this will require development of the program as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 13 in the 6th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined "any" the following: 'subsequent'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "implementation" and inserting in its place the following: 'progress'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Dedicated Revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to carry out the purposes of this Act.
