15	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the
17	enacting clause the following:
19	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted
21	as emergencies; and
23	Whereas, the landowner relations program may be implemented during the fall of 1989 and this will require development of the program as soon as possible; and

27	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
29	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
31	safety; now, therefore,
33	Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 13 in the
35	6th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after th underlined " <u>any</u> " the following: ' <u>subsequent</u> '
37	Further amend the bill in section 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "implementation" and inserting in its place the following: 'progress'
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41	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of
43	fact the following:
45	'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from Dedicated Revenue to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to carry out the purposes of this Act.

17	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
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21	FISCAL NOTE
23	This legislation will result in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife absorbing costs associated with the
25	analysis required for the landowners relations program. Also, this bill requires an allocation of dedicated revenues to the
27	Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife in the amount of \$5,000 for fiscal year 1989-90 and \$5,000 for fiscal year
29	1990-91. This allocation provides funds for additional analysis and general operating expenses.'

33	STATEMENT OF FACT
35	This amendment alters the language of the bill to ensure that the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is not
37	prohibited from implementing the landowner relations program as early as fall of 1989 and adds an allocation section and a fiscal
39	note.
