COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1062, L.D. 1484, Bill, "An Act to Fund the Maine State Retirement System for Certain Employees Previously Covered by the County Retirement System"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the word "section" and inserting in its place the following: '~~section~~ sections 18202 and'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. The higher rate of retirement benefits due employees under the provisions of this Act shall commence October 1, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies that the provisions of this bill will not be in conflict with another section of law requiring participating local districts to agree to legislative changes.

The amendment makes it clear that the additional payments due retired employees are to be due on a prospective, not retroactive, basis.
