45	This bill establishes new requirements for the form o
47	hunting licenses. The bill requires that hunting licenses be weather resistant, of sufficient size to contain at least 1
49	authorizations of land use and contain an identification numbe which must be in characters at least 4 inches high. The bil
51	makes it an offense to hunt for animals and birds without wearing the license. The license must be worn on the upper body and the identification number of the license must be visible.
