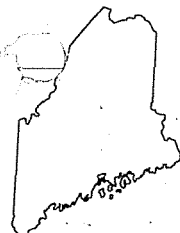

23 This bill provides funds to be used by the Department of  
Human Services, Bureau of Maine's Elderly, to award grants to  
25 independent congregate meal programs. The bureau shall set up  
rules and guidelines to govern the awarding of the grants, which  
27 shall range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 per recipient.
