STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act Amending the Law Governing the Maine Committee on Aging.

(After Deadline)

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §5112, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 793, §11, is amended to read:

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6. Inform the public. Inform the public in consultation
7 with the bureau, to develop a firm public understanding of the current status of the survival of Maine's elderly, including
9 information on effective programs elsewhere in the State or nation, by collecting and disseminating information, conducting
11 or commissioning studies and publishing the results thereof and by issuing publications and reports for which a reasonable fee
13 may be charged;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the Maine Committee on Aging to collect reasonable fees for issuing publications and reports.
