An Act to Allow Vanity Registration Plates for Certain Trailers.

(After Deadline)



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §192, first ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 415, §4, is**
5 further amended to read:

7 The Secretary of State is authorized to design and to issue,
9 under such regulations as ~~he shall deem~~ the Secretary of State
11 determines appropriate, initial type registration plates or
13 combination of initials and numeric type registration plates to
15 be used on passenger motor vehicles or motor vehicles of the
17 station wagon type or pickup trucks or motorcycles or motor homes
19 or truck trailers or trailers ~~not to exceed 2,000 pounds~~, whether
21 semitrailers or 4-wheeled type or camp trailers, as defined in
23 section 1, subsection 1-G, in lieu of other numeric type
25 registration plates. Such plates shall be of such design and
shall bear such letters or letters and numbers as the Secretary
of State shall prescribe, but there shall be no duplication of
identification.

21 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 This bill clarifies that vanity plates may be used for truck
25 tractors and all types of trailers as defined in Title 29.
