An Act to Allow Vanity Registration Plates for Certain Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §192, first ¶, as amended by PL 1987, c. 415, §4, is further amended to read:

The Secretary of State is authorized to design and to issue, under such regulations as he-shall-deem the Secretary of State <u>determines</u> appropriate, initial type registration plates or combination of initials and numeric type registration plates to be used on passenger motor vehicles or motor vehicles of the station wagon type or pickup trucks or motorcycles or motor homes <u>or truck trailers</u> or trailers net-te-exceed-2,000-pounds, whether semitrailers or 4-wheeled type or camp trailers, as defined in section 1, subsection 1-G, in lieu of other numeric type registration plates. Such plates shall be of such design and shall bear such letters or letters and numbers as the Secretary of State shall prescribe, but there shall be no duplication of identification.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill clarifies that vanity plates may be used for truck tractors and all types of trailers as defined in Title 29.
