An Act to Clarify the Definition of Seasonal Workers under the Workers' Compensation Law.



1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3	39 MRSA §2, sub-§2, ¶B-1, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 559, Pt. B, §14, is amended to read:

	B-1. Notwithstanding paragraphs A and B, the average weekly
7	wage of a seasonal worker shall be determined by dividing
	the employee's total wages, earnings or salary for the prior
9	calendar year by 52. A seasonal worker is a worker employed
	at any task which is substantially time-limited in terms of
11	annual performance within a seasonal industry as defined by
	Title 26, section 1251, and appropriate rules.

15	STATEMENT OF FACT
17	The bill reduces confusion regarding the status of seasonal
	workers under the workers' compensation law by adopting the

seasonality standards existing under the employment security law.
