Resolve, to Create a Pilot Program to Provide the Driver Education and Evaluation Program to Persons Incarcerated for Driving under the Influence of Drugs or Alcohol.



1 **Sec. 1. Pilot program. Resolved:** That the Department of Human
3 Services shall develop as a pilot project the provision of the
 Driver Education Evaluation Program to persons incarcerated for
 operating a motor vehicle under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

7 Under the pilot program, initial portions of the Driver
 Education Evaluation Program will be made available in nonjail
9 settings to incarcerated persons while they serve their
 sentences. If the period of incarceration is insufficient to
11 complete the program, the remainder of the program shall be
 completed after release from jail; and be it further

13 **Sec. 2. Results of project. Resolved:** That the Department of
15 Human Services shall review the feasibility, effectiveness and
 costs of providing on a statewide basis portions of the Driver
17 Education Evaluation Program to persons during their
 incarceration. The results of this project shall be published in
19 a final report to be submitted to the 114th Legislature by
 February 1, 1990.

21 The report to the Legislature shall include recommendations
23 of any changes to laws and rules that are necessary to implement
 this project on an on-going statewide basis; and be it further

25 **Sec. 3. Appropriation. Resolved:** That the following funds are
27 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of
 this Act.
