HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1092, L.D. 1525, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Penalty for Destruction of Law Enforcement Canines"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first indented paragraph the following:

'Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §1014, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 383, §4, is repealed.'

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title by striking out all of the 4th line (page 1, line 21 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 17-A MRSA §752-B is enacted to read:'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§752-B." in paragraph A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 29 in amendment) by inserting before "certified" the following: 'which that person knows or reasonably should have known is'

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "§752-B." in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 1, line 32 in amendment) by inserting before "certified" the following: 'which that person knows or reasonably should have known is'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies the person must know, or reasonably should have known, that the dog is certified for law enforcement use.
