21	Enactment of this resolve would result in:
23	1. A Highway Fund allocation to the Department of Transportation (Highway Maintenance, Acct. #05745.5) in the
25	Transportation (Highway Maintenance, Acct. #05745.5) in the amount of \$62,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation would provide funds for 1.5 seasonal custodial positions and
27	anticipated construction costs for a proposed dumping station; and
29	2. An increase in dedicated revenue and an allocation to the Department of Transportation in an amount which cannot be
31	determined at this time. This increase in revenue would be derived from the proposed establishment of a nominal fee to help
33	defray the anticipated operating costs of the dumping station.'

37	STATEMENT OF FACT
39	The amendment carries out the intent of the resolve to establish a demonstration dumping station project for
41	recreational vehicles, but it reduces the project to a single site. The site will be selected by the Department of
43	Transportation at a rest area on Interstate 95 in the most feasible location based on use, municipal approval and access to
45	disposal capability.
