COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1095, L.D. 1528, "Resolve, to Establish as a Demonstration Project Recreational Vehicle Dumping Stations"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2 dumping stations" and inserting in its place the following: 'a dumping station'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 4th line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "rest areas" and inserting in its place the following: 'a rest area'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "sites for the stations" and inserting in its place the following: 'site for the station' and in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "stations" and inserting in its place the following: 'station'

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the last line by striking out the following: "1990." and inserting in its place the following: '1990; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. Resolved: That the following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

Enactment of this resolve would result in:

23

1. A Highway Fund allocation to the Department of

25

Transportation (Highway Maintenance, Acct. #05745.5) in the

27

amount of \$62,000 for fiscal year 1990-91. This allocation would
provide funds for 1.5 seasonal custodial positions and
anticipated construction costs for a proposed dumping station; and

2. An increase in dedicated revenue and an allocation to

31

the Department of Transportation in an amount which cannot be

33

determined at this time. This increase in revenue would be
derived from the proposed establishment of a nominal fee to help
defray the anticipated operating costs of the dumping station.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment carries out the intent of the resolve to

41

establish a demonstration dumping station project for

43

recreational vehicles, but it reduces the project to a single

45

site. The site will be selected by the Department of
Transportation at a rest area on Interstate 95 in the most
feasible location based on use, municipal approval and access to
disposal capability.
