An Act to Allow Employers to Collect a Service Charge for Debt
Collection from Employees.



1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 14 MRSA §3127-B, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

5 8. Fee for employer payment assessed. An employer or other
7 payor of earnings of a judgment debtor who has been ordered to
9 pay installments directly to a judgment creditor under this
section may collect a fee of \$5 from the judgment debtor for
every such installment paid to the judgment creditor.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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15 This bill allows an employer, who has been ordered by a
17 court to pay part of an employee's earnings to a creditor of the
employee, to charge the employee a fee of \$5 for each payment
made to the employee's creditor. This is designed to cover the
employer's costs of processing such payments.
