STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

An Act to Utilize French Heritage in Maine and to Create the Francophone Center.

#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 Sec. 1. Advisory committee established. There is established the Advisory Committee to the Francophone Center within the University of Maine System. This committee shall be composed of 5 the following 15 members who shall have an interest in the preservation and utilization of Franco-American heritage 7 and represent a broad geographical cross section of the State: 10 9 Legislators, 5 of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate and 5 of whom shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and 5 members appointed by 11 the Governor. The duties of the committee shall include facilitating 13 the development of international educational programs in French and advising the Francophone Center on matters concerning 15 programming, planning and funding.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

\$500,000

Provides \$400,000 for the creation of the Francophone Center within the University of Maine System and \$100,000 to the University of Maine at Fort Kent for preservation of Franco-American heritage.

### STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides funds for the establishment of а 37 Francophone Center within the University of Maine System. The purpose of this center is to establish programs to attract and 39 educate French-speaking students from other countries and enhance and expand the French language skills of the students and faculty of the University of Maine. The center will develop programs to 41 teach educational courses in various disciplines, using French as 43 the language of instruction. The center will also develop opportunities for students to study in other countries where 45 French is spoken and facilitate the preservation and maintenance of the French language and French heritage. The bill provides for the creation of an advisory committee to help implement the 47 goals of the center.
