HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1122, L.D. 1554, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Communicable Disease Law"

Amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "§816." by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 15, lines 24 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'1. For private institutions. Any private institution, its employees or agents shall be immune from civil liability to the extent provided in Title 14, chapter 741, as if that institution were a state agency and its employees and agents were state employees, for any acts taken to provide for the confinement or restraint of a person committed pursuant to this chapter or for participating in reporting under this chapter.'

Further amend the bill in section 10 in that part designated "§816." in subsection 2 in the first line by striking out the following: "2. For persons not associated with private institutions." and inserting in its place the following: '2. Reporting and proceedings.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment retains the immunity provided by current law for private institutions carrying out this Act.
