

SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1122, L.D. 1554, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Communicable Disease Law"

Amend the bill in section 10, in that part designated "816." in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 15, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "liability" the following: 'to the extent provided in Title 14, section 8104-D and section 8105, subsection 1.' and in the 3rd line (page 15, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: 'without malice.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment changes the immunity provision of the bill and reflects the liability limitations that apply to the State.
