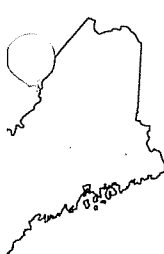

**An Act to Provide Complimentary Maine Drivers' Licenses to Veterans
with 100% Combat Service Connected Disability.**

(AFTER DEADLINE)



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **29 MRSA §536 is amended to read:**

5 **§536. Amputee veterans**

7 On application to the Secretary of State ~~of~~ any amputee
9 veteran who has been the recipient of an automobile from the
11 United States Government under authority of ~~P.L.~~ Public Law 663,
13 79th Congress, as amended, or ~~P.L.~~ Public Law 187, 82nd Congress,
15 as amended, ~~or~~ any amputee veteran receiving compensation from
17 the Veterans Administration for service connected disability who
 shall have a specially designed motor vehicle or any veteran with
 100% combat service connected disability, and who is otherwise
 qualified to operate a motor vehicle in this State, ~~such~~-veteran
 shall receive a license to operate ~~such~~ an automobile without the
 requirement of the payment of any fee.

21 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

23 Currently, an amputee veteran who has a special motor
25 vehicle is entitled to free motor vehicle registration and a free
 driver's license. This bill provides a free driver's license to
 any veteran who has a 100% combat service connected disability,
 if the veteran is otherwise qualified to receive that license.
