An Act Concerning Unemployment Benefit Eligibility.

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1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
. 3 .	26 MRSA §1192, sub-§12 is enacted to read:
5	12. Individuals on recall status. An otherwise eligible
	individual need not comply with the requirements of subsections 2
7	and 3 if an employer certifies that the individual has been laid
	off by the employer because of lack of work and has a definite
9	offer of recall to work with that same employer.

	STATEMENT OF FACT
13	
	This bill amends the eligibility requirements for
15	unemployment benefits to allow for provision of benefits to
	individuals on "standby" status or awaiting recall to
17	employment. These individuals currently are required to actively seek other employment, but this bill will exempt them from that
19	requirement.
