This amendment changes the definition of "training costs" to allow a municipality that is entitled to reimbursement from another municipality that hired away one of its police officers to recover the full cost of uniforms it furnished to the officer in training and the base salary paid to officers newly hired or working overtime hours to fill in for the officer in training.

The amendment also adds a fiscal note. 15
