An Act Regarding the Training Costs of Police Officers.

(AFTER DEADLINE)



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **25 MRSA §2808, sub-§1, ¶C**, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 506, Pt.
A, §50, is amended to read:

5
7 C. "Training costs" means the full cost of the salary paid
9 to the officer while in training, the full cost of the
11 tuition charged by the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, plus
13 any overtime paid to others to provide police protection
15 during the officer's absence. In determining training
17 costs, charges for overtime, paid to the officer in
training, when they--are applicable, shall always be
calculated as and reimbursed at a rate that is not more than
25% of--the--salary--paid--to above that officer's regular
nonovertime rate of pay; any overtime paid to other persons
to provide police protection during the absence of the
officer while in training shall be fully reimbursed at that
other person's regular overtime rates.

STATEMENT OF FACT

25 This bill amends the definition of "training costs" for
police officers for the purposes of training cost sharing by
imposing a 25% cap on any trainee's overtime.
