1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
3,	30-A MRSA §3106 is enacted to read:

7	A municipality may establish a schedule of user fees on

9	to, the use of public dumps and sewers. These user fees may
•	exceed the actual cost to the municipality of the provision of
11	those services, and may be used by the municipality as a means of raising revenue.

	STATEMENT OF FACT

	This bill permits municipalities to establish user fees on
19	services provided to its residents, such as public garbage dumps
21	and sewers. This will allow municipalities to raise revenue by means other than the property tax.
