HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1147, L.D. 1590, Bill, "An Act to Establish the Bureau of Juvenile Corrections"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph from the end before the fiscal note (page 2, lines 48 to 50 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 11 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 11. Effective date. Section 1 of this Act and the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-A, sections 6001 to 6003 in section 11 of this Act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment. Sections 2 to 10 of this Act and Title 34-A, sections 6004 to 6007 in section 11 of this Act shall take effect on October 1, 1991.'

This amendment clarifies the effective date provision of the bill and committee amendment.
