An Act to Amend the Snowmobile Registration Laws.

This bill provides that a registration sticker will be issued at the same time a snowmobile is registered. By rule, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will require that the stickers clearly distinguish between residents and nonresidents and that the stickers be prominently displayed. The bill also increases the amount of the nonresident snowmobile registration fee which is credited to the Snowmobile Trail Fund and makes the amount of the fee which goes to the department the same for
