HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1605, Bill, "An Act to Require Counselors of Operating under the Influence Offenders to Approve Restoration of Drivers' Licenses"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph C in subparagraph (1) in the last line 9 page 1, line 47 in amendment) by inserting at the end the following: 'and'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph C by striking out all of subparagraph (2) (page 2, lines 2 to 5 in amendment) and by renumbering the subparagraphs to read consecutively.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

This amendment eliminates an unnecessary limitation on appeals of certain decisions of counselors employed by the Driver Education Evaluation Program.
