**An Act to Require Counselors of Operating under the Influence
Offenders to Approve Restoration of Drivers' Licenses.**



1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **22 MRSA §7202-A** is enacted to read:

5 **§7202-A. Mandatory recommendation of restoration of drivers'**
7 **licenses**

9 All counselors of the Division of Driver Education
11 Evaluation, certified pursuant to section 7205, shall, without
13 discretion, approve and recommend the restoration of a client's
15 driver's license within 6 months after completion of the
17 education component of the applicable program described in
19 section 7203, provided that during this period, the client has
21 participated in any recommended treatment program and has not
23 been convicted or cited for any other alcohol or drug related
25 motor vehicle incident.

19 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

21 This bill requires counselors to approve restoration of
23 drivers' licenses within 6 months for individuals convicted of
operating under the influence of alcohol or drugs who have
25 completed the applicable course provided by law.
