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An Act Regarding the Composition of the Real Estate Commission.

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1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

3 **32 MRSA §13062**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 395, Pt. A, §212,  
5 is amended to read:

7 **1. Real Estate Commission composition.** The Real Estate  
9 Commission, established by Title 5, section 12004, subsection 1,  
11 shall be referred to in this chapter as the "commission." The  
13 commission shall consist of 4 industry members and one public  
15 member. No more than 3 members of the commission may be members  
17 of the same political party. The remaining 2 members shall be  
19 from a major political party.

#### 15 STATEMENT OF FACT

17 This bill requires that no more than 3 members of the Real  
19 Estate Commission be members of the same political party. The  
remaining 2 members must be from a major political party.
