SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1179, L.D. 1634, Bill, "An Act to Revise the Asbestos Certification Law"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 25 and 26 in amendment) by striking out the stricken words and figures "~~in an amount greater than 10 square feet or 3 linear feet~~" and inserting in their place the following: 'in an amount greater than 10 3 square feet or 10 3 linear feet'

Further amend the amendment in section 4 by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Exemption. Asbestos abatement activities undertaken in single-unit residential buildings of 4 dwelling units or less shall be exempt from the requirements of this section if limited to heating equipment and performed by persons licensed by the Oil and Solid Fuel Board under Title 32, chapter 33, to install, repair, remove or service heating equipment. Asbestos abatement activities related to disposal undertaken at licensed asbestos disposal sites are exempt from the requirements of this section.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends the definition of asbestos abatement activity to mean handling asbestos-containing materials in an amount greater than 3 square feet or 3 linear feet. The amendment also allows persons licensed to install, repair, remove or service heating systems to perform asbestos abatement activities in single-unit residential buildings if limited to heating systems.
