An Act to Provide Funds for Preparation and Training of Class I and Class II Drivers.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)

 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, the qualifications and training of operators of commercial vehicles are a matter of public interest and concern; and

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9 Whereas, a viable motor transport industry is a critical component of the economy of the State; and

Whereas, the motor transport industry requires a pool of 13 trained and qualified vehicle operators to provide the service required by the people and industry of the State; and

Whereas, there now exists no funding to support training which will allow members of the public ready and reasonable access to the skills and knowledge necessary to enter the motor transport industry as operators of commercial vehicles; and

21 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 23 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 25 safety; now, therefore,

27 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

## <u>CHAPTER 315-A</u>

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE EDUCATION

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## <u> \$8621. Board of Commercial Vehicle Vocational Education</u>

 L. Board established; membership. The Board of Commercial Vehicle Vocational Education is established under the supervision of the Division of Adult and Community Education. The board shall have 5 members, to include representatives of the Division of Adult and Community Education, the motor transport industry, the general public, and commercial driving schools, all of whom shall be appointed by the commissioner, and a representative of the Division of Motor Vehicles to be appointed by the Secretary of State.  2. Rulemaking authority. The board shall establish by rule guidelines regarding instruction and the disbursement of funds
pursuant to this chapter in accordance with the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375. Rules shall
be made under this subsection within one year after the effective date of this chapter.

3. Funds. Funds received by the board under Title 29,
9 section 246, section 246-B, subsection 5, and section 582,
subsection 6, shall be disbursed by the board to commercial
11 driving schools.

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13 4. Interim disbursement. Pending adoption of rules under subsection 2, funds under this chapter shall be made available to adult education programs that demonstrate to the Director of Adult and Community Education that the training programs for commercial drivers meet or exceed the truck driver training requirements of the Board of Commercial Driver Education and that are certified by the Board of Commercial Driver Education and commercial driving schools.
