HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1185, L.D. 1640, Bill, "An Act to Provide Funding for and to Amend Laws Governing the Maine Human Services Council"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "~~§463.~~" in subsection 5 in the 9th to 15th lines (page 3, lines 45 to 50 and page 4, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Aid to Families with Dependent Children, alcoholism, drug abuse and mental health, child abuse, developmental disabilities, education, energy, health, juvenile justice, low-income energy assistance, and other human development, health, income supplementation, social service, training, transportation or winterization funds or grants or federal block grants"

Further amend the amendment in that part designated "~~§464.~~" in subsection 4 by striking out all the 2nd sentence (page 5, line 20 to 27 in amendment).

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment eliminates reference to specific federal laws for which matching funds may be available to the State and removes the commission's authority to review certain proposals and contracts.
