11 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

12 This bill creates, as a demonstration project, 3 household
13 hazardous waste removal and disposal sites. The project would
14 facilitate the pickup and disposal of many hazardous materials
15 currently found in homes and garages, including aerosols,
16 bleaches, drain cleaners, paints, fertilizers, automobile fuels
17 and batteries, and moth balls. The bill establishes a committee
18 to oversee and implement the project. Results from the project
19 shall be reported to the Legislature. If the demonstration
20 proves successful, it will be used as a model for an ongoing
21 statewide plan.
