Resolve, to Grant a Temporary Psychologist's License to Bruce W. Webb.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)



1 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
3 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

5 Whereas, Bruce W. Webb is a psychologist determined to be
eligible for a temporary license under the supervision of a
7 licensed psychologist under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32,
section 3824; and

9 Whereas, Bruce W. Webb is currently unable to practice
11 without the issuance of a temporary license; and

13 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
15 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety; now, therefore, be it

19 **Temporary licensure. Resolved:** That, notwithstanding Title
32, chapter 56, subchapter II, and any rules promulgated under
21 that subchapter, the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists
shall grant Bruce W. Webb a temporary license to practice as a
23 psychologist in this State, under the supervision of a licensed
psychologist, while completing the requirements for permanent
25 licensure. Bruce W. Webb shall be eligible to take the licensing
examination given by the State Board of Examiners of
27 Psychologists upon completing the application process for the
examination.

29 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
31 preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

37 This resolve requires the State Board of Examiners of
Psychologists to grant Bruce W. Webb a temporary license to
39 practice as a psychologist under the supervision of a licensed
psychologist and establishes that he shall be eligible to take
41 the licensing examination given by the State Board of Examiners
of Psychologists.
