IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE

Resolve, to Grant a Temporary Psychologist's License to Bruce W. Webb.

(AFTER DEADLINE)

(EMERGENCY)

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Bruce W. Webb is a psychologist determined to be eligible for a temporary license under the supervision of a licensed psychologist under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 3824; and

Whereas, Bruce W. Webb is currently unable to practice 11 without the issuance of a temporary license; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Temporary licensure. Resolved: That, notwithstanding Title 32, chapter 56, subchapter II, and any rules promulgated under that subchapter, the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists shall grant Bruce W. Webb a temporary license to practice as a psychologist in this State, under the supervision of a licensed psychologist, while completing the requirements for permanent licensure. Bruce W. Webb shall be eligible to take the licensing examination given by theState Board of Examiners of Psychologists upon completing the application process for the examination.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve requires the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists to grant Bruce W. Webb a temporary license to practice as a psychologist under the supervision of a licensed psychologist and establishes that he shall be eligible to take the licensing examination given by the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists.
