Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Aroostook County for the Year 1989.

(EMERGENCY)



1 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after 3 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and County Aroostook has certain expenses liabilities which must be met as they become due; and Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1989 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and 11 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts 13 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately 15 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it 17 Sec. 1. Aroostook County; taxes apportioned. Resolved: following sum is granted as a tax on Aroostook County to be 19 apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of 21 paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar year 1989: 23 1989 TAX 25 \$2,701,132 27 ; and be it further 29 Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized.
