35	majority vote of the" and inserting in its place the following: 'only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the'

39	Further amend the bill in section 18 in the 3rd line (page 8, line 52 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "voting"
41	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of

	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
