SENATE AMENDMENT " D " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 594, L.D. 1671, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART D" by inserting after section 2 the following:


'Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §4008, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 783, §4, is amended to read:

4. Unlawful dissemination; penalty. A person is guilty of unlawful dissemination if he knowingly disseminates records which are determined confidential by this section, in violation of the mandatory or optional disclosure provisions of this section. Unlawful dissemination is a Class E crime, which, notwithstanding Title 17-A, section -4-A- 1252, subsection -4- 2, paragraph E, is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 30 days.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes a reference to a repealed section and replaces it with a more appropriate reference.
