SENATE AMENDMENT "I " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 594, L.D. 1671, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART D" by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 28-A MRSA §1007-B is enacted to read:


§1007-B. Surcharge on part-time Class VI licenses

In addition to the license fee for part-time Class VI licenses provided in section 1007, subsection 2, paragraph B, there is imposed a \$5 surcharge on all part-time Class VI licenses issued after September 28, 1987. This section is repealed October 15, 1989.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment inserts a section on liquor license surcharges needed to correct inaccurate license fees in the statute. It was inadvertently omitted in printing the committee amendment to L.D. 56, now Public Law 1989, chapter 158.
