SENATE AMENDMENT "K " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 594, L.D. 1671, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART D" by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 17-A MRSA §1152, sub-§2, ¶C, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 821, §3, is amended to read:

C. A suspended fine, suspended in whole or in part, with probation as authorized by chapter 49;


Sec. 4. 17-A MRSA §1152, sub-§3, ¶B, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 157, §1, is amended to read:

B. A suspended fine, suspended in whole or in part, with probation as authorized by chapter 49;'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies what is current law; namely, that a fine may be partially suspended or wholly suspended accompanied by probation.
