SENATE AMENDMENT " L " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 594, L.D. 1671, Bill, "An Act to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART D" by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 17-A MRSA §1152, sub-§2, ¶¶ F and G, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 821, §3, are amended to read:

F. A term of imprisonment as authorized by chapter 51; or


G. A fine as authorized by chapter 53. Subject to the limitations of section 1302, such a fine may be imposed in addition to the sentencing alternatives in paragraphs B, D, E and F; or

Sec. 4. 17-A MRSA §1152, sub-§2, ¶ H is enacted to read:

H. A county jail reimbursement fee as authorized by chapter 54-B.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects an oversight that occurred when the new sentence alternative in chapter 54-B, section 1341 was added to the Maine Criminal Code. Section 1152, subsection 2 is designed to include all sentence alternatives applicable to natural persons with the single exception of restitution which is addressed in subsection 2-A.
