
Amend the amendment in that part designated "PART D" by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 17-A MRSA §6, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1981, c. 324, §9, is further amended to read:

1. The provisions of ~~chapters 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 47, 49, 51, 53 and 54~~ Parts 1 and 3 and chapter 7 are applicable to crimes defined outside this code, unless the context of the statute defining the crime clearly requires otherwise.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment clarifies references to provisions in the Maine Criminal Code relating to general principles of criminal law, punishment and other offenses applicable to crimes outside the code, specifically including the chapter on intensive supervision.
