25	its employees. For the purposes of this section "law enforcement agency" has the same meaning as set forth in section 3701.

29	STATEMENT OF FACT
31	This amendment makes it clear that the limit on local
33	firearms regulations does not interfere with law enforcement agency authority to regulate the guns used by law enforcement
35	officers as employees of that agency.
